# FALLS CREEK YOUTH CAMP DRESS CODE

All apparel judgements will be left to the **discretion of the Falls Creek Staff (FCS)**. If FCS determines a camper or campers should change their clothing to fall in line with camp requirements, then said camper or campers are required to do so.

**ALWAYS ACCEPTABLE SHIRTS**

**Shorts must be modest.** Modest can be generally defined as extending to just beyond the finger tips or a 5" to 7" inseam.

Sleeveless shirts must extend all the way to the shoulder seam.



Dresses/Skirts must reach the top of the knee.



Shoes must be worn at all times outside of your cabin.



Tights may be worn under a garment that meets the dress code. **Tights/sliders do not extend the length** of garments worn over them (shorts/skirts/dresses). **Tights are not pants.** No tight fitting or revealing clothing. This includes leggings or similar attire, which cannot be worn as pants.

T-shirts and cover-ups **must be worn** to and from swimming venues.

Should wear swimsuits of modest length (fingertip) and not tight fitting

Campers **may not be barefoot** on the way to and from venues.

SWIMWEAR



No tank tops or shirts cut down the sides.



Undergarments must always be covered by outer garments (i.e. no boxer shorts hanging out or bra straps showing).



No Midriiffs/racer backs. No sport bras as tops (includes the 5k).



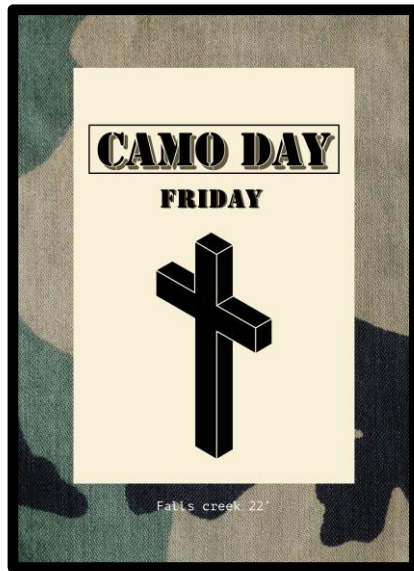
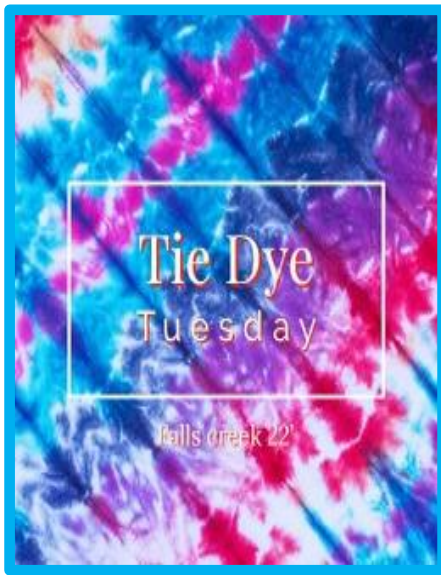
No spaghetti strap tank tops/dresses.

## Student Pick Up:

If you have to pick up your student from camp, the procedure has changed.

You must:

1. Let John know ASAP the day and time of pick up.
2. Remind John on the day of pick up.

When you arrive at the High Road Gate (6714 Hwy 77D Davis, OK):

3. If your student and a FBCW Sponsor is not at the gate already, then let the Gate Attendant know and they will notify our cabin and we will bring your student to the gate.

*This process is the same for Student Drop Off.*

## ▪ Student Medication

Students are NOT allowed to keep their own medicine unless approved by both John and a Parent.

If your child needs to take medicine at camp:

1. Fill out the medicine form on the back of the Falls Creek Release Form.
2. Inform John of medicine needed at the Parent Meeting
3. A Sponsor will be assigned to disperse the medicine to the student when needed.
4. On the day we leave, bring medicine in a Ziploc bag.
  - i. NOT in the Student's Suitcase
5. Give the medicine to the assigned Sponsor, before we leave the church.
